



XpressionManager

Description

Xpression app downloads orders, invoices, picking lists and the print documents from any XpressionManager portal, directly into your Enfocus Switch workflow. The download consists of a folder structure, equal to the order structure. Where the full order number is a folder with the full xml order file, followed by each orderline with an xml orderline and a printable file (pdf).

**** As of September 2020, the XpressionManager has become a bundle, and the XpressionManager order update app has been added to update order or sub-order status anywhere in your workflow. ****

XpressionManager is a modern and highly scalable Web2Print and brand management tool. With XpressionManager you can set up a web portal for each of your customers with customer-specific products or materials and custom templates. Customers can then create and order corporate identity products. There are also integrations with various single-sign-on and purchasing (ERP/MIS) systems.

!!Important:

Before you install and configure XpressionManager, please contact GrafiStore or XpressionLabs. If you haven't changed order statuses yet, XpressionManager will download the full order history from your portal, which can lead to problems. You will also need credentials for the App to communicate with your brand portal(s).

If you want to test the App, be sure to set the environment setting to 'Test' and provide an order number to download.

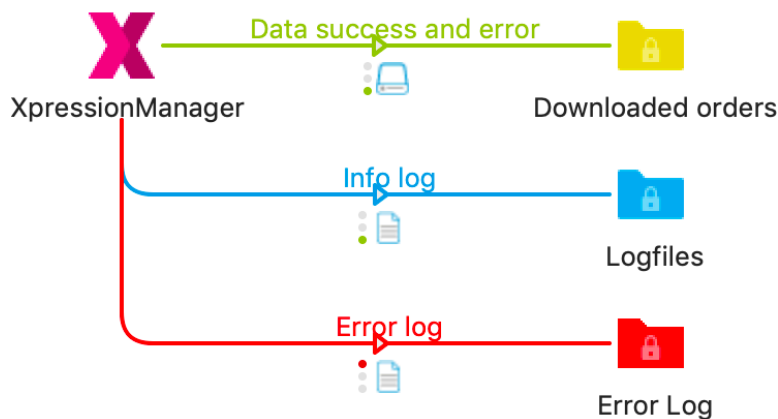

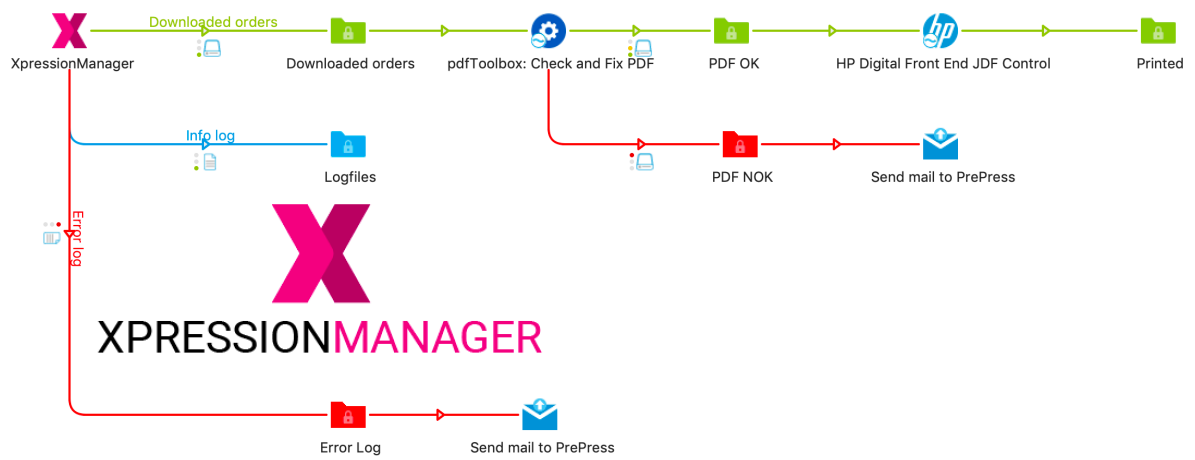

- **XpressionManager Url**
 - This is the url to your XpressionManager portal
- **Check Interval (in minutes)**
 - Checks for new orders every x minutes
 - Minimum is 1 minute
- **Account name**
 - Account name provided by XpressionLabs
- **XpressionManager secret**
 - Secret key provided by XpressionLabs
- **Environment**
 - Choice between Live or Test
 - Test: Downloads a single order, without checking or setting order status
 - Live: Downloads all new orders having order status 2 (English: ordered / Dutch: besteld) and sets the order status to 3 (English: processing / Dutch: In behandeling) when the order is downloaded.
- **Order number**
 - When Environment is set to Test, the order number needs to be provided
- **Download invoice**
 - Download the order invoice
- **Download delivery receipt**
 - Download the delivery receipt
- **Download picklist**
 - Download the picklist

1.2 Example workflow

Workflow Description:

- XpressionManager downloads new orders;
- If an error occurs, PrePress will receive an email with error details
- For downloaded orders pdfToolbox checks the pdf files for errors and fixes them if possible;
- When the PDF is OK, Switch will send the file directly to a HP Indigo to print
- When the PDF is Not OK, PrePress will receive an email with error details





XpressionManager order update

Update order or suborder status anywhere in your workflow.

Flow Element Properties

- **XpressionManager Url**
 - This is the url to your XpressionManager portal
- **Account name**
 - Account name provided by XpressionLabs
- **XpressionManager secret**
 - Secret key provided by XpressionLabs
- **Order type**
 - Choice: Order number / Suborder number. Either you change the order status, or the suborder status.
- **Order status**
 - Number: The order or suborder status
