

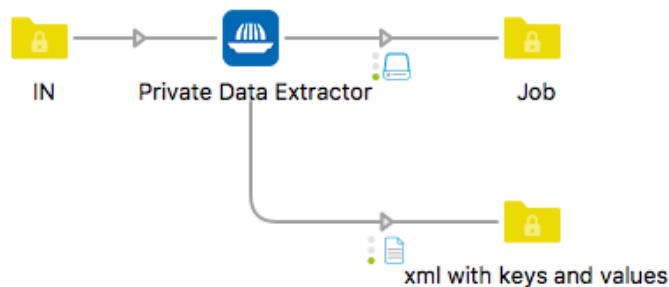
Private Data Extractor

Description

Reveal the private data in your job, even if you don't know the correct private data keys.

Private data can come from another script or app.

The private data keys and values will be shown in the log, added as a dataset and exported to an xml file.



Flow elements properties

- Show in job log
 - Show or not private data keys and values in the job log
- Dataset name
 - Name of xml dataset to add to the job
- Export XML
 - Export private data keys and values as separate xml file.
Will be sent to 'Log' outgoing connection.
- Exported XML file name
 - Exported XML file name, default [Job.NameProper] Private Data. The .xml file extension will be added automatically.

Due to xml restrictions, an xml node can not begin with a number. If so, an underscore will be added before the name of the private data. And the characters space, &, <, >, ', " will be deleted.

Compatibility

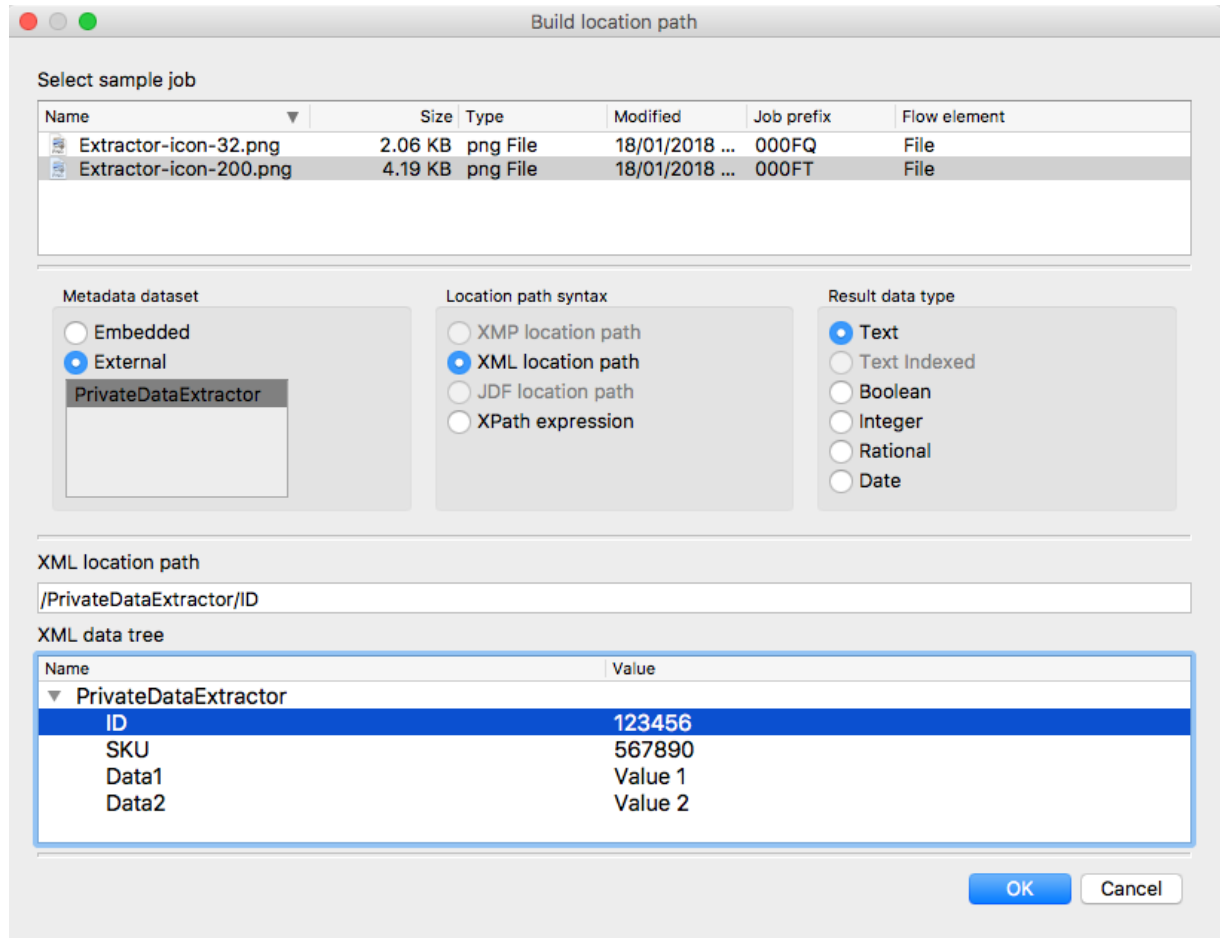
Switch 18 and higher, Windows & Mac

Connections

Private Data Extractor requires at least one input and one output connection of type “Data”. The job will be sent to the “Data” output connection(s).

If you want to export an xml file with the job private data keys and values, add an output connection of type “Log”.
