

Sort by preflight state



Sort by preflight state is a default Switch app that sorts incoming Enfocus Certified PDF files depending on their preflight state: Error, Success, Warning or Sign-off.

Keywords

Keywords can be used with the search function above the Elements pane.

The keywords for the **Sort by preflight state** element are:

- Enfocus
- Status check
- PDF
- preflight
- error
- success
- warning
- sign-off

Connections

This app allows one or more incoming connections and requires one or more outgoing connections.



Note: Only single files are accepted; job folders are sent to the Problem jobs folder.

The **outgoing connections** have an extra property, **Certified PDF state**, that determines which files are sent along the connection. Options are:

- Success
- Warnings
- Errors
- Sign-offs
- Certified but not valid
- Not certified

Note that you can combine several Certified PDF states in one outgoing connection, for example Errors and Warnings.

Files that not match one of the configured Certified PDF states are moved to the Problem jobs folder.

Properties

Property	Description
Element type	The flow element type: Sort by preflight state. This property is useful to identify renamed flow elements. It cannot be changed.
Name	The name of the flow element. Default is "Sort by preflight state".
Description	A description of the flow element displayed in the canvas. This description is also shown in the tooltip that appears when moving your cursor over the flow element.
Ignore modification date	It's possible that a file is modified after it was preflighted. In that case, there is a difference between the last modification date and the preflight date. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If the modification date should be ignored, select Yes.• If the modification date should be taken into account, select No. The modification date and the preflight date will be compared, and if a job was modified more than 1 minute after being preflighted, it is moved along the connection with Certified PDF state set to 'Certified but not valid' (or, if not available, to the Problem jobs folder).
