

Log job info



Log job info is a default Switch app that issues a (warning, debug or info) message to the Switch execution log containing the value of the specified metadata field. It is intended mainly for use while testing a flow.

For example, you could issue a warning message whenever a file arrives in a particular flow element, or an info message that displays the size, the priority, the submission date, ... of each job moving along the flow, ...

For further analysis of your messages, you could use a Switch app like [Switch Logger](#) or [DataLogger](#)

Keywords

Keywords can be used with the search function above the Elements pane.

The keywords for the **Log job info** element are:

- metadata
- debug

Connections

Log job info allows only a single outgoing connection.

Properties

Property	Description
Element type	The flow element type: Log job info. This property is useful to identify renamed flow elements. It cannot be changed.
Name	The name of the flow element displayed in the canvas
Description	A description of the flow element displayed in the canvas. This description is also shown in the tooltip that appears when moving your cursor over the flow element
Message text	The message to be logged (inline value, single-line text with variables or script expression).
Message level	Determines the message level: Info, Warning, Debug or Error
