## What's new:

### Disabling an instance

The PLC version 2421 brings a new method: `/shutdown` that will let you shut down an instance through an API Call. When calling this method, the PLC will first ensure that any ongoing processes come to completion. It will then shut down the instance once all workers are idle.

**GET** `/shutdown`

**This API is used to shutdown the container instance**

For example, if you started an instance on a server whose URL is `https://my.server:12345`, you can disable it calling `https://my.server:12345/shutdown`

The following JSON message should be returned:

```

  "statusCode": 202,
  "message": "Request received for shutdown the PLC instance"
}
```

If you need to disable multiple instances, then you need to call the `/shutdown` method on each instance. Note that this is an asynchronous call, the PLC will first wait for any ongoing process to end before shutting down the instance.

To monitor when the instance is shut down, you may need to call the `/isAlive` method until it returns an error.
